Great news! In December we announced that we had met our Stage One goal of raising \$35,000 for Broadcast Australia costs. These costs consist of the site fees at the Loxton tower facility operated by Broadcast Australia, and the associated electricity supply. Now we are in Stage Two where our aim is to complete all remaining payments by 31st March, including the advance payment of six months of Broadcast Australia site and electricity fees to the end of June. We are still making progress and the remaining figure now needed is \$14,000.


Introducing our new Sales Rep
