

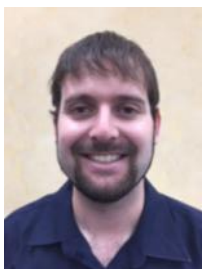
## Christmas is coming!

We hope that you enjoy the sounds of Christmas on Riverland Life FM!

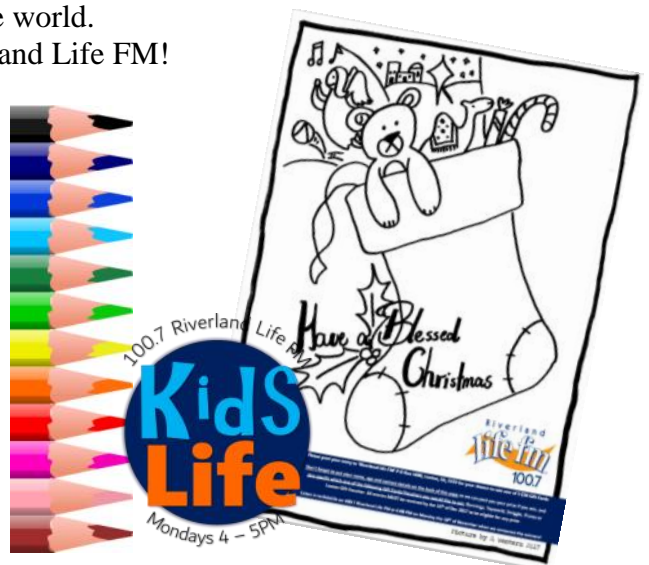
### NEW BOARD
